Adult Social Club – Activity Description

The Adult Social Club, offered by the Kostopulos Dream Foundation, allows Adults with special needs, ages 18 and up, to expand their social circles, while learning how to use community resources. This program is designed to assist adults in developing self-efficacy, leisure skills, independence, and interpersonal relationships. Transportation is provided from 1 of the 4 pick-up locations and each participant will be dropped off at their home at the conclusion of the activity.
