Summer Camp - May-Aug we provide Residential, Trip, Day, Partner, and Specialty Camps. Residential, Trip, and Specialty Camps are 5 days/4 nights, and Day and Partner Camps are Specialty Camps are dedicated to children/teens with Neurofibromatosis, Organ Transplant, and Muscular Dystrophy, and campers come from all over the US, Canada, UK, and other international locations. Residential, Day, Partner and Specialty Camps are held at our campus in Emigration Canyon. Travel Trip camps include destinations such as Salt Lake Valley, Park City, Zion, Jackson Hole, Yellowstone, Bryce Canyon, Capitol Reed, and Bear Lake. Our campers include individuals with autism, cerebral palsy, Down syndrome, muscular dystrophy, spina bifida, Prader Willi, spinal cord injury, traumatic brain injury, vision/hearing impairments, amputees, developmental/learning delays, ADHD, learning disabilities, veterans with PTSD, and others. We also provide "Adventure Days" and Mini-Camps for Hill Airforce Base, Intermountain PKU, St. Ambrose, and others. Additionally, Ropes/Teambuilding/Leadership Trainings would typically be provided. Due to the pandemic, we were not able to run our Residential, Trip and Partner Camp Programs for the Summer of 2020. We continued our Day Camp Programs and opened these programs to everyone regardless if they have a disability or not. From May - Aug 2020 we provided 15 weeks of Day Camp, had a total of 1044 campers, providing 610 program hours and 8,777 service hours. The Day Camps are 5 days a week and held at our campus in Emigration Canyon where campers ride horses, swim, fish, hike, and more. By reimagining and reengineering our programs, implementing strict policies and procedures, and by remaining in the red risk zone we were able to open our summer camps early and run 15 weekly sessions. Community Based Programs - from October 2019-March 2020 provided 3 to 4 activities weekly for children and adults with disabilities.
